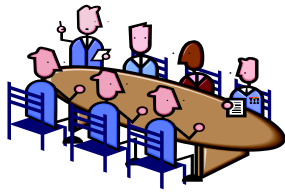


Attention UBC Board Members!!!! The July board meetings will be at 6:30PM, August 17 & 31.

A Note From the Pastor...

God Wants Us To Be Discerning. Discernment is the ability to distinguish between good and bad, wise and foolish, right and wrong, true and false. God was pleased that Solomon asked for discernment (1 Kings 3:9-12). The entire book of Proverbs was written to help us to develop discernment. Jesus reprimanded those who were unwilling to discern between true and false teachers and religion. (Revelations 2:14, 20) Yet today tolerance is in and discernment it out. There are popular speakers and writers today who claim to be Christians yet are preaching a different gospel. They deny hell and question whether people need to trust Christ as Savior in order to go to heaven. One of the more popular false teachers is Rob Bell. His popular NOOMA videos are used in many churches, even in our own community. In his video (Bullhorn Man) Bell speaks of people like you and me.

Bell says: *They say that "If I don't repent I might burn in hell. I might die tonight." That's why the hell, fire, and brimstone stuff is so dangerous. When they tell me that you need to follow Jesus or you will burn in hell it sounds like a threat. . . That's not what Jesus did." I don't understand what condemning and converting has to do with Jesus' message.*

Yet because **Jesus** loved people He did warn them of hell more than any other figure in the Bible. (cf Matthew 5:22,29-30; 10:28; 18:9; 23:13-39)

Bell says, *"People just need somebody to listen and not to preach to them, and not to try to convert them but just to listen to their story, their pain, their dream." Jesus doesn't wave heaven in front of people like a carrot on a stick.*

Jesus said, "Truly I say to you, unless you are converted and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven. (Matthew 18:3)

Jesus said, "You are from below, I am from above; you are of this world, I am not of this world.²⁴ "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am *He*, you will die in your sins." (John 8:23-24)

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me. (John 14:6)

Jesus said, "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,²⁰ teaching them to
